

Step 3: tape your ribbon (s)down with the raw edges about ¼” below your placement line. I would also suggest taping your d-ring(s) down to keep them from hopping around when the sign is stitching.
Run Color Stop 2-3.
2- This with tack down your hardware.


3- this with give you the placement line for your 1st piece of vinyl (6x8)



Step 4: Place your vinyl
Run Color stop 4.
4- Stitches tackdown




Step 5: Use your applique scissors of choice to trim all the way around the vinyl. BE VERY CAREFUL TO NOT CUT YOUR RIBBONS!
Run Color stop 5.
5- stitches placement die line



Step 6: Place your top vinyl so it covers the whole placement line and **Run Color Stop 6.**
6- stitches tack down




Step 7: Use your applique scissors of choice to trim all the way around the vinyl. BE VERY CAREFUL TO NOT CUT YOUR RIBBONS!
Run color stops 7-9
7- 8 Stitch design elements
9- stitches applique placement die line



Step 8: Place your yellow caution sign vinyl and **Run color stop 10.**



Step 9: Use your applique scissors of choice to trim all the way around the vinyl and **Run Color stops 11-13**
11- yellow sign satin
12-words satin divider lines
13- back of sign placement line



Step 10: take your hoop off of the machine and flip your hoop over. Securely tape the backing vinyl piece on so that it won't fall off. Gravity is a real pain sometimes.

Run Color Stop 14



Step 11: Get those applique scissors out one more time and trim around the back as close as you can without snipping the tack down stitches. **Run Color stop 15.**



Step 12: Remove from hoop trim most of the WSS away then use your preferred method to remove the last of it with HOT water. You can use a washcloth or tooth brush if you don't want to soak it.
