

**How to ITH Corner
Bookmark**

Materials: Medium - heavy weight cut away stabilizer.
Tapey Tape

Measurements are Height x Width

Please see special notes for info about fabric exterior cut sizes

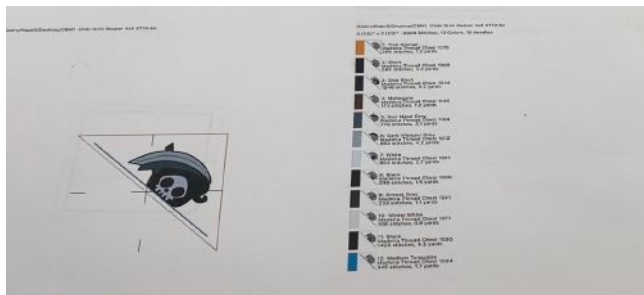
(3) marine vinyl 4"x 4"

(1) olyfun 4"x4 "

SPECIAL NOTES:
THIS IS A 2 HOOP PATTERN. Don't worry it's not hard.

Before we get started let's take a look at the color stop sheet that comes with your design files. Go ahead and make notes.

For Hoop 1 you'll run the file with the Pretty design on it labeled CMB 1 in your files.



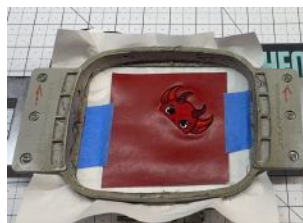
Color stop 1- Die line

The design colors stops will be next. They will vary in number depending on which design you are doing, You should stich the 2nd to last stop in a color to match your vinyl, but it's almost always listed as black.

The last color stop is a forced color stop to allow you to put your olyfun lining on the back. You should also stitch this in a color to match your vinyl, which again is almost always black.



Step 1: Now you can hoop some medium weight cutaway and **Run Color stop 1.**



Step 2. Place one of your vinyl pieces making sure to cover your die line. **Run all the color stops except the last one.**

Step 3:Now that they awesome design is stitched we're going to flip the hoop over and tape the olyfun on. Tape is a must because gravity is a thing and it's not always our friend.

Run the last color stop.

Step 4:Remove your stitched corner from the hoop and trim away the excess so you it's easier to make the cuts you need to do next.

Step 5: use a ruler and rotary cutter and cut the vinyl 1/8" BELOW the line under the design. Do not cut the other two edges at this time. Set this aside until we're ready for it in the next hooping.

NOW LET'S DO THE 2nd HOOPING! You will be running the file listed as CBM2



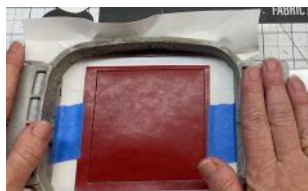
Step 6: Hoop up some medium weight cutaway and **Run Color stop 1.**



Step 7: We have a die line! **This is different – FLIP THE HOOP OVER and tape one of your vinyl piece to it, making sure to cover your die line.**



Flip you hoop back to the front and place your last vinyl piece making sure you've covered the die line.
Run Color Stop 2.



Step 8: Color stop 2 just tacked those vinyl pieces in place.
Now you need to line up your corner. The first thing you want to do is make sure that the edge of the diagonal is right in the EXACT corner of the tack down. If it isn't your bookmark won't be open all the way across the cut.



Step 8: cont

You also want to make sure that you have the same amount of Vinyl on the left and right so your design is centered and tape it down. **Run Color Stop 3.**



Step 9: Trim any thread tails from the final bean stitch and then unhoop.



Step 10: Use a ruler and rotary cutter to trim around the final stitch leaving about 1/8" allowance on all 4 sides.



Now you can slide on to your current read.
